# WDO'S FIRST FIELD ACTIVITY IN COLLABORATION WITH IOFS AND CILSS IN THE REPUBLIC OF NIGER

Niger – May 2022. WDO, represented by its Senior Program Officer, Ms. Rabiatou Ahmadou, participated in a Capacity-building Workshop for Farmers on Water Management in Agriculture. This activity, the first of its kind for WDO, was a tripartite partnership with the Islamic Organization for Food Security (IOFS) and the Permanent Interstate Committee for Drought Control in the Sahel (CILSS).

This impressive training saw the participation of 70 farmers, of whom 34 were women from the Tahoua Region. The trainers were then overseeing the implementation and scaling of this knowledge to approximately 300 farmers—200 of whom will be women.

In her statement on behalf of the Executive Director of WDO, Ms. Ahmadou emphasized the significance of women's participation in decision-making relevant to water management and irrigation activities.

Additionally, the Minister of Promotion of Women and Child Protection, Her Excellency Allahoury Aminatou, received Ms. Ahmadou. They stressed the importance of continued collaboration between WDO and the Republic of Niger.











